Interview to Elizabeth Bain, IP & Licensing manager at STFC, UK and future chair of HEPTech

STFC has been elected in December 2020 to replace GSI in chairing HEPTech from 2022.

What is your vision on HEPTech in a 2 years perspective?

o To build on the work undertaken by GSI, to consolidate the HEPTech vision, increase the network's visibility among HEP organisation's and grow the network to include many more likeminded institutions.

What are the first steps to be taken in this direction?

o To increase our activity with Technology Transfer networks facilitating knowledge sharing and proactively encourage our network to market their HEP successes.

Which challenges will you have to face?

o We are all busy and time poor, persuading the busy Technology Transfer teams to prioritize the HEPTech network opportunities has always been a challenge.

How are you going to deal with them?

o We must make the network the place to be. Create a vibe. Over the last year the network has held more frequent short events that are increasingly well attended by the staff in our member organization's. Creating the marketing materials that can be easily channeled into member organizations existing communications channels has been key to increasing attendee numbers. It is up to us to build on the success of the last year to join with other networks in brokerage and sharing knowledge and information that can enhance and elevate HEP Technology Transfer.

HEPTrepreneurs

HEPTrepreneurs is the new online series of events organised by HEPTech for all those interested in entrepreneurship and knowledge transfer. Here young people can check and discuss alternative careers to research. Moreover technology transfer officers have the opportunity of discussing with potential entrepreneurs.

The first two events held in April and May had Ash Ravikumar from CERN KT group and Pietro Faccioli from an INFN /University of Trento startup in biotechnologies as speakers. After Q & A sessions a networking event was also organized, where smaller groups of people could interact with each other around specific topics given by the organization. A participation of around 35 participants for each events.

ELI ERIC is officially established by the European Commission

The establishment of the Extreme Light Infrastructure (ELI) ERIC opens the door for researchers, industry and countries to gain access to the world's largest collection of super powerful and ultra-fast lasers for science. The European Commission has taken a long-anticipated decision to establish the Extreme Light Infrastructure (ELI) as a European Research Infrastructure Consortium, or ERIC. The ELI facilities make up the largest, multi-site laser facility in the world. The host countries, the Czech Republic and Hungary, applied in May 2020. The decision to approve the application comes after years of intense negotiations.

Several GSI/FAIR research areas receive EU funding in the millions. Four planned infrastructure projects in the fields of tumor therapy with heavy ions, innovative methods for industrial radiation testing and new technology developments for accelerator facilities were successful in current EU tenders and have received funding commitments. FAIR and GSI play a decisive role in each of these projects, which are carried out in international collaborations.

Merging technology with entrepreneurship helps to drive innovative solutions to existing challenges. With this in mind, the CERN Entrepreneurship Student Programme (CESP) returns for its fourth edition,
